

Hemblington Primary School: KS2 Attainment 2016-17

KS2

In 2016-17, we had 27 children in Y6, all of whom were entered for the KS2 National Curriculum Tests in reading, SPG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and mathematics. In line with statutory requirements, we made teacher assessments for writing.

Attainment (scaled test scores of 100 and above are the expected standard)

Reading:

Teacher Assessment - Working at the Expected Standard = 92.6%

Test – Working at the Expected Standard = 77.8% (National 71%)

Test – Working at a high standard = 22.2% (National 25%)

Average scaled score for cohort = 105.3 (National 104.1)

Writing:

Teacher Assessment – Working at the Expected Standard or above = 85.2% (National 76%)

Teacher Assessment – Working at Greater Depth = 29.6% (National 18%)

Maths:

Teacher Assessment - Working at the Expected Standard = 85.2%

Test – Working at the Expected Standard = 85.2% (National 75%)

Test – Working at a high standard = 25.9% (National 23%)

Average scaled score for cohort = 105.5 (National 104.2)

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar:

Test – Working at the Expected Standard = 88.9% (National 77%)

Average scaled score for cohort = 109.8 (National 106)

Reading, Writing & Maths combined

At expected standard or higher = 66.7% (National 61%)

Working at a high level = 22.9% (National 9%)

Average Progress from KS1 – KS2

Reading = 0.5

Writing = 2.1

Maths = 0.6
