Privacy Notice - Students - Data Protection Act 1998

The Yare Education Trust is the Data Controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act. We collect and hold personal information relating to our students and may also receive information about them from their previous school, local authority and/or the Department for Education (DfE). We use this personal data to:

- support students' teaching and learning
- monitor and report on their progress
- provide appropriate pastoral care
- assess how well the school and the Trust, as a whole, is doing

This information will include contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information, any exclusion information, where students go after they leave us and personal characteristics such as ethnic group, any special educational needs a student may have as well as relevant medical information.

We are required, by law, to pass some information about our students to the DfE. This information will, in turn, then be made available for use by the LA.

The DfE may also share student level personal data that we supply to them, with third parties. This will only take place where legislation allows it to do so and it is in compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998.



Decisions on whether the DfE releases this personal data to third parties are subject to a robust approval process and are based on a detailed assessment of who is requesting the data, the purpose for which it is required, the level and sensitivity of data requested and the arrangements in place to store and handle the data. To be granted access to student level data, requestors must comply with strict terms and conditions covering the confidentiality and handling of data, security arrangements and retention and use of the data.
