Solve



Can you find any lines of symmetry in this photo? Can you draw a butterfly with only one line of symmetry? Can you draw one with three lines of symmetry?

Respond



Write a descriptive story about a butterfly's first flight. Where does it go? What does it do? What does it see?

Reimagine



Create a symmetrical painting by cutting out a paper butterfly, painting one half then folding the paper in half to transfer the paint to the opposite wings.

Discover



Fact: The swallowtail is Britain's largest butterfly, so named because the hind wings look like the tail of a swallow.

Question: Research how other butterflies got their names. Can you see any butterflies from your window?

Discuss



Caterpillars transform dramatically into butterflies. How do humans change as we grow up? How do you think you will change as you get older?
