'A Bao A Qu' by Mason  
Bates. Taken from his  
Anthology of Fantastic  
Zoology

'A Bao A Qu' is an  
imaginary breed of snake  
that slithers up and down  
the staircase of a famous  
tower in India called The  
Tower of Victory

Listen for the middle of A  
Bao A Qu, when the  
music starts winding  
itself back to the start.  
The piece is a musical  
palindrome, and just like  
a palindrome word is  
spelt the same forwards  
as it is backwards, the  
music sounds the same  
when played forwards or  
backwards!

**Why not try some art  
while you are  
listening to it? Draw  
a picture of what  
think the A Bao A Qu  
looks like by  
listening to the  
music. Or have a go  
at creating your own  
piece using sounds at  
home.**
