This week, your work is all going to come from BBC Bitesize, like the maths has done for the last couple of weeks.

There's maths as normal and today looks at **Comparing fractions, decimals and percentages**. The English today is Story writing: **Settings and fronted adverbials**. Then there will be one other task for you to do - today is **science: Life cycles in humans and animals**.

Some tasks that you'll get will be good revision and some will be new learning. There will be videos, interactive tasks and worksheets for you to use.
