

4 in a Row Game

Year 5/6 Statutory Word Spellings

HOW TO PLAY

Play with a partner. The object of the game is to be the first to get four correct answers in a row – this can be horizontally, vertically or diagonally. Roll a dice each time to decide from which column to pick a sentence (the columns are numbered 1-6). If there are no sentences left in that column, either skip a go or roll again (decide on the rule you want to play).

Each sentence features a misspelled word from the Year 5/6 Statutory Word Spelling list. Write it correctly on the game board, or if there is not enough space on a piece of paper. You can use a different coloured pen to record your spellings on the board or add an initial or symbol to the space on the board if there is not space to write the correct spelling. If you don't spell the word correctly, you will have to wait until your next turn to try again. You might want to get a third person to act as a spelling checker.
