



## OUTDOOR GAMES

### Tom Fiddler's Ground

One part of the playground (or whatever area you are playing in) is marked off as 'Tom Fiddler's Ground' - it is usually best to draw a line with chalk or mark it off with a rope. In this area one child is selected to be Tom Fiddler. He/she is only allowed to stay in this area and cannot cross the line at any time.

In Tom Fiddler's ground objects should be scattered around that the rest of the class must try and retrieve (small bean bags are good for this).

The rest of the class have to try and cross over to Tom Fiddler's ground and collect the objects, whilst singing "Here I am on Tom Fiddler's ground, picking up gold and silver!"

The child who is playing Tom has to try and catch the 'thief', but only when they are on his ground.

If 'Tom' manages to catch a 'thief' that child then becomes the new Tom Fiddler and the game begins again.
