

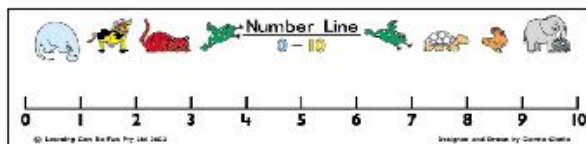
Swan Autumn 2020 News

Welcome to Swan Class, we are all looking forward to an exciting year. To encourage engaged learners, we follow the children's interests and plan the curriculum around the topics that inspire them. We will cover the following areas.

The children have already shown an interest in animals. We will find out about a range of British animals and animals from other countries. This will be a good introduction to the science work later in the term.



In Maths we will work on counting, writing and reading numbers to 20 and then 100. The children will investigate numbers that add up to make 10 and then 20. We will look at 1 more and 1 less and how to record calculations.



In Computing the children will work in the IT suite and learn to log on and off the computer and use the mouse on simple programs.

In Science, the children will study the human body. They will name parts of the body and discuss the five senses.

In Geography the children will explore Norfolk, East Anglia and find out about England and Scotland.



In PSHE the children are talking about being ill and what can make them feel better. We will talk about taking, and being safe with medicine.

RE will be based on symbols in Christianity and Judaism.

PE is on Wednesday and Thursday. Please come to school in trainers and a tracksuit (or leggings and sweatshirt) for outdoor PE.
