Welcome back to our Summer term. Our topic is History-based and will be looking at the Industrial Revolution and Victorian times. This will be a cross-curricular topic and we will be linking our English, Art and Science.



Maths - we will continue with our White Rose Scheme. With Miss Rogers we will be consolidating arithmetic to include using the four operations, fractions and percentages.

With Mrs Pearson, we will be learning about data handling: line graphs, pie charts and calculating the mean.

HOMEWORK: Daily reading is really important: good readers become good writers, and reading can also develop our knowledge of the world and our empathy! We expect daily reading. We will be setting work using the CGP books - and this will also be put on googleclassroom. Although the SATS tests won't be going ahead, we still need the knowledge and skills tested by the SATS for High School.

Topic:

History: The Industrial Revolution and life in Victorian England. We will studying a significant turning point in British History, including learning about the first railways. We will take an aspect of the Industrial Revolution, learn about the changes and significance, and present our findings in a filmed documentary.

Art:- Find out who the Pre-Raphaelites were and explore their artwork, discussing features and what they like or dislike about it. Explore the artwork of William Morris and the arts and crafts movement. Find out about Victorian decoupage and use decoupage to create a piece of artwork. Decoupage is the art of decorating a surface with paper cutouts that are glued on in layers.

Science:- Electricity Recap knowledge of circuits from year 4. Investigate varying effects of using different components in circuits using fair tests, predictions and analysing results to produce conclusions..

Computing:- Explore 3d modelling using Tinkercad: how it might be used in real life and become confident using it to complete a mini project by understanding what the software does.
