

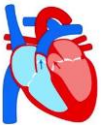


English

We will be looking at a text called 'Floodland'. Our writing will include descriptions, diary entries and writing in role as different characters. Our punctuation and grammar will focus on Sentence structure and types of clauses, coordinating and subordinating conjunctions and relative clauses. Our second text is 'Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief'. Our writing will include journalistic writing, instructions, information texts and chronological texts. Our punctuation and grammar will focus on active and passive voice, using direct and reported speech and () - - , , for parenthesis.

Maths

We continue to use White Rose Maths this year. We will be covering place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions and position and direction. Lessons will use a mixture of WRM resources amongst others to support and stretch children.



Science

Our science topic this term is Animals Including Humans. I am dividing this into the Circulatory System & Nutrients and Healthy Lifestyle.

Computing

We will be using *Project Evolve* for online safety: managing online information and privacy and security. The class will continue to use Espresso for coding.

HOMEWORK

For the autumn term, the class will have a topic based homework grid to choose from. Soon, each child will also receive a set of CGP books in which English and Maths homework will be set.



MFL

The class will be recapping numbers up to 100 and telling the time. They will also be learning about eating out and shopping: menu items, ordering, paying and money.

RE
