School and Eco Councils

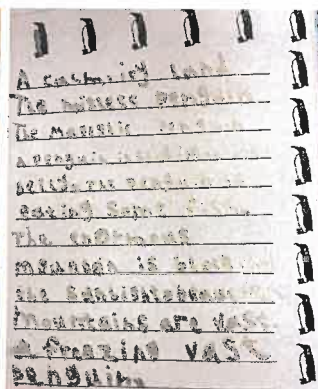
