



Robin Class Curriculum News Summer 2023 Oh I do like to be beside the seaside!

English

Our English this term is based on Olga da Polga by Michael Bond. From this quality text, the pupils will be writing letters, a 'just so' story about how Olga lost her tail, a newspaper report and an alternative ending to the story.

Science

This term we are going to be learning about living things and their habitats - including things that are living, dead, never been alive; habitats and adaptability; plants, animals, habitats; simple food chain and sources of food.

Geography

We will find out about seas and coasts: learning about physical and human features of our seas and coasts. We will also learn about jobs and resources that are linked to the sea.

History

We will find out about the history of the seaside, with a particular focus on the Victorians: how their seaside holidays were the same and different using a range of historical sources to deepen understanding.

PSHE

We follow the <u>SCARF</u> scheme and the themes for this term are 'Being my best' and 'Growing and changing' Please see me if you would like to see further details of the curriculum.

Computing

We will focus on internet safety as a constant feature of our computing work and how to use a computer correctly. We will be using google docs to create posters and present information. We will also be using espresso linked to our seaside topic.

After half term we will try to make a stop frame animation.

Maths

We teach Maths based on the White Rose Maths scheme. This term we are learning about: statistics, measurement: time, mass, capacity and We will revise fractions and temperature. arithmetic using the four operations.

RF

We will learn more about Christianity linked to the Bible and Jesus' teachings initially and Judaism core beliefs after half term.

Music

We will learn more about musical contrasts including: rhythm, pitch, dynamics, articulation, melody and timbre.

PE

The children are completing an 'under the sea' gymnastics unit with a focus on balance and performance, linked to our overall seaside topic. They will be practising athletics skills throughout the summer term.

Art/DT

In DT we will be learning about food technology with a seaside theme. Pupils will be designing and making seaside snacks, such as a boat themed wrap, creating fruit kebabs and trying traditional seafood snacks. In art we will be exploring colour mixing using primary and secondary colours, through the work of Kandinsky.



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
