English

Our English will be based around Berlie Doherty's Street Child. We will focus on writing a diary and a biography. We will continue to embed uses of colons and parenthesis. We will look at features for diary writing, such as question tags and colloquialism. For our biographies we will focus on cohesion: a huge part of Y6 writing.

We have daily reading sessions. We aim to foster a reading culture in the classroom; please support us at home by regular reading. Reading books should be in school every day.

Maths

Throughout this half term, we will be covering BIDMAS: order of operations, fractions and converting units. Lessons will use a mixture of White Rose Maths resources amongst others to support and stretch children.

Science

Our science topic this half term is electricity.

Geography

This half term we will study Transport Links across the UK. This continues from our industrial revolution topics.

PSHE

We follow the SCARF scheme and the theme for this term is Valuing Difference.

Computing

We will be using Google Sites within the unit Creating media – Web page creation.

RE

Our next RE unit asks the learning question, 'Do Christmas celebrations and traditions help Christians understand who Jesus was and why He was born?'

Music

We are beginning to use a new music scheme: Kapow. This half term the class will be exploring film music.

PE

Our PE days for this half term will be Monday and Friday. Some children will be returning to the swimming pool alongside Y5; others will remain at school for PE. The children will be having cricket on a Monday, delivered by an outside instructor and on Friday it will be Gymnastics.

DT

We swap to DT for this half term. Our unit looks at Electrical systems. We will be making a steady hand game.

MFL: French

The class will be consolidating the following areas, describing themselves, clothes and weather.
