 - Sonya went on to say that some were asking for tea and coffee so perhaps offer that next year too
- Cakes Stall £160
 - 12 boxes of 6 Mince Pies bought, with 6 left over
 - 192 Snowmen made with half left over
 - Left over items were then sold at the Tuck SHop or as part of the refreshments offered and the Christmas performances at school
 - It was agreed that next time we will ask for cookies, brownies, cupcake, mince pies and snowmen
- Kids Tombola Boxes
 - This sold out quite quickly, KAtrina who manned the stand said the choosing of the box took too long.
 - We agreed that as it was quite popular we would run thi again next year but use paper bags as the donated boxes were all used
- Bottle Tombola
 - Jenny suggested for the next bottle tombola we reduce the odds
- Raffle
 - The total did include the £250 from Snellings. Ticket sales were down on last year even though we had more prizes.
